

Birding Half Moon Bay - July 19, 2014

Get-a ways along California's Pacific Coast - Trip Leader – Lisa Myers



Quick Overview – The Let's Go Birding / Los Gatos Birdwatcher summer birding trips are planned to get us out of the valley heat and to some place cooler while introducing folks to new places & nature. This day had us birding the open spaces of Half Moon Bay. During the morning we walked the old ranch road found at Burleigh/Murray State Park and after lunch we moved to the coast to check out "Wavecrest". The birds were rather quiet, so we had to work a bit harder to find a few species. A species only found in the west, the Wrentits were all around us throughout our morning. They called repeatedly and several crossed our path as they flew from patch to patch. We also talked about the differences in the flycatcher species since we encountered four different species. A flock of Pygmy Nuthatch was a favorite for the day. And while a few of us caught a glimpse of a Gray Fox darting into the landscape, all had great looks at the Garter Snake that sat in the middle of our path. After lunch we walked a trail through Wavecrest and to the cliff's edge where we scanned the ocean and found dolphins, resting grebes, two species of cormorants and more. We also watched a female Northern Harrier disrupt an extended family of White Tailed Kites. Numbering over 10, the harrier kept harassing the kites and causing disruption for all. We ended our day with an immature Red-shouldered Hawk sitting in the shadows of a Cypress.
